

## **Creston School District No. 073**

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## **CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROCESS**

The following curriculum development process is predicated on establishing a five year curriculum development process with a six year instructional materials purchasing cycle. The focus is to provide a fixed budget amount in each year's budget that will support instructional material purchase, implementation and training costs throughout a curriculum cycle. While the reality is that secondary instructional materials are front-loaded (funds expended the 1<sup>st</sup> year) and elementary instructional materials will be divided over the six years of the curriculum cycle. This reflects the difference between an expensive textbook adoption and one with annual consumable materials costs.
