Creston School District No. 073 is a kindergarten through twelfth (K-12) grade comprehensive school located in Creston, Washington and serving the communities of Lincoln, Seven Bays, Deer Heights, Deer Meadows, and surrounding agricultural land. Creston and Wilbur School Districts have entered into a Secondary Academic Cooperative where all high school students from both districts will attend in Wilbur and all Junior High School students from both districts will attend school in Creston. Both districts will maintain their own elementary schools.

Creston School District is located in rural Eastern Washington, approximately 60 miles west of Spokane on State Highway 2. One building serves approximately 42 students in grades K-6 and 77 students in grades 7-8. Ethnic profile is approximately 91% Caucasian and combined 9% other races. The free and reduced lunch rate is 36.7%. (2016)
