Student instructional materials will be available for your inspection. This information may be helpful for you and your child to have meaningful family discussions both before and after the classroom presentation.

Following this preview night, parents who wish to have their child excused from participation in the class may sign a release form. State law provides that a parent or legal guardian must attend such a meeting before they can excuse their child from participation in the HIV/AIDS prevention program.
